

Vocational Nursing Instructor

POSITION SUMMARY:

The instructor is responsible for teaching one or more assigned courses described in the Vocational Nursing Program Curriculum. This includes utilizing effective teaching/learning tools, i.e., audio-visual equipment and reference materials, teaching plan preparation, providing learning experiences following an established course outline, managing students in classroom, lab and clinical areas, evaluating students by testing and other related means, and reporting on and recording individual student progress. The instructor may be assigned teaching duties in the classroom, laboratory and/or clinical facilities. In lab/clinical facilities, the instructor is responsible for the guidance and supervision of the students and provides a quality learning experience in a daily post-conference, post-clinical. The instructor monitors and reports on student conduct, performance and effectiveness in the clinical environment.

JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Instruct classes in anatomy & physiology, pharmacology, nursing fundamentals, medical-surgical nursing, family nursing, pediatrics, mental health nursing, rehabilitation, gerontological nursing, communicable diseases, leadership and supervision
- Participate in planning, developing, implementing, evaluating and revising curriculum
- Have a daily teaching plan which correlates the theory and practice offered to the student and have this plan available to the Director of the VN Program
- Make recommendations regarding student retention, dismissal and readmission
- Plan for and evaluate learning experiences for students in the clinical facility, with the aid and cooperation of other faculty members, the Director of the VN Program and relevant clinical affiliates staff
- Measure the effectiveness of student performance in clinical facilities by conferring with nursing and service personnel
- Evaluate the progress and performance of students, in cooperation with other faculty members on a continuous basis
- Serve as an advisor to students in matters that affect student performance
- Provide individual tutoring to students when such assistance is deemed necessary to improve the student's performance
- Record attendance, grades and progress of students in a timely and accurate manner
- Attend and participate in all faculty meetings
- Participate in faculty development activities on a continuous basis
- Assist as required with college activities such as student orientation, graduation, etc., as requested by the Director of the VN Program
- Maintain knowledge of current developments in nursing, nursing education and health care

MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

An instructor in the Vocational Nursing program shall have or be currently attending a course offered by an approved school in teaching; and shall meet the requirements of section A or B, below:

(A) Registered Nurse:

1. Hold a current California active license as a Registered Nurse; and
2. Hold a baccalaureate degree from an approved school; or a valid teaching credential; or have completed a minimum of one year full- time teaching experience in a state approved registered nursing or vocational or practical nursing, or psychiatric technician school within the last five years; or met community college or state university teaching requirements in California; and
3. Have a minimum of two years experience as a registered nurse or licensed vocational nurse within the last five years.

(B) Licensed Vocational Nurse:

1. Hold a current California active license as a Vocational Nurse; and
2. Hold a baccalaureate degree from an approved school; or a valid teaching credential; or have completed a minimum of one year full- time teaching experience in a state approved registered nursing or vocational or practical nursing, or psychiatric technician school within the last five years; or met community college or state university teaching requirements in California; and
3. Have a minimum of two years experience as a vocational nurse within the last five years.
